Class Title: RESCUE SYSTEMS 1

Date: DECEMBER 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14, 2018

Time: 0800 - 1700 ★must attend all 40-hours

Description: Must be Agency / Department sponsored. This course meets the requirements for California State Fire Marshal requirements for OES engine crew personnel. This class contains: an introduction to Urban Search and Rescue planning and operations, Rescue Scene organization and management, rescuer safety and various rescue systems, lifting and moving heavy objects, emergency building shores, breaching and bracing, and basic rope rescue.

Location: SLO County Drill Grounds: 1666 Tehama Ave, San Luis Obispo, CA 93405

Pre-requisites: 1. SFM Firefighter 1 certificate or equivalent Wildland or equivalent (SFM FF1 check off sheet done at the stations and 6 months of permanent time as a FF1) and
2. SFM Low Angle Rope Rescue Operational (LARRO) certificate.
BOTH copies must be included with registration.

Fee: \$400.⁰⁰ Cashiers check made out to SLO COUNTY FIRE. Course enrollment and Fee Exemption for Permanent and LT CAL FIRE SLU Personnel, Station 21 and Station 30 PCFs with Station Captain signature / approval on registration; see how to Register below.

Requirement: All Students Must Be On-Duty during instructional hours of Training and all applications require Station Captain signature approving registration

Bring: Wildland or structure helmet w/ goggles, wildland nomex pant & coat, leather work gloves, boots, drinking water, #2 pencil and notebook. Bring your own lunch and water.

Awarded: State Fire Marshall **CFSTES** Certificate
