**Class Title:** HAZ-MAT FRO and DECON

**Description:** Must be department sponsored/affiliated. This CSTI certified course is designed to provide first responders with the knowledge and skills to safely respond to Haz-Mat incidents, and is required to respond as a Paid Call or Reserve Firefighter. Students will be enrolled in both Haz-Mat FRO and Decon – no exceptions. Students must be fit tested and be medically cleared to use a SCBA, and be familiar with the use. This course is sponsored by SLO County Fire Training Officers, and SLO County Fire Department

**Requirement:** All Students Must Be On-Duty during instructional hours of Training and all applications require Supervisor signature approving registration.

**Materials Fee:** Includes 2 **CSTI** Certificates, student books and Tyvek suit; You must be affiliated with a fire department to take this class. If your registration is not properly authorized by a Captain or above, it will be returned.

**Fee:** \$300.<sup>00</sup> Cashier's Check or Money Order **only** payable to **SLO County Fire**. Attach to registration and mail to Training - Must be submitted with Registration. Course enrollment and Fee Exemption for current SLU PCFs

**What to bring:** If you are Not a CAL FIRE / SLO County Fire employee - bring a SCBA and one spare bottle for Decon day; #2 Pencil and notebook
