Class Title: Rescue Systems 1, Basic Rescue Skills

Dates: December 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 2020

Times: 0800 to 1700 all days ★ must attend all hours

Description: Must be Agency / Department sponsored. This course meets the requirements for California State Fire Marshal requirements for OES engine crew personnel. This class contains: an introduction to Urban Search and Rescue planning and operations, Rescue Scene organization and management, rescuer safety and various rescue systems, lifting and moving heavy objects, emergency building shores, breaching and bracing, and basic rope rescue.

Prerequisites: 1. SFM Firefighter 1 certificate or equivalent Wildland or equivalent (SFM FF1 check off sheet done at the stations and 6 months of permanent time as a FF1) -and-
2. SFM Low Angle Rope Rescue Operational (LARRO) certificate. Both copies must be included with registration Non-negotiable.

Fee: \$400 Cashier's Check or Money Order payable to **SLO COUNTY FIRE / RS1**, make sure student name is in the memo section. USPS cashiers check preferred, must be valid through 01/11/2021. Payment must be attached to registration. Course enrollment and fee exemption with Station Captain approval for Permanent and LT CAL FIRE SLU Personnel, Station 21 and Station 30 PCFs. Questions regarding registration fees, email SLU.training@fire.ca.gov. Registration is on first-come, first serve basis. Cancellations less than 10-days, no-shows or failures will forfeit fees.
