Description: Hazardous Materials Incident Commanders are trained to manage hazardous materials emergencies beyond that of the First Responder. Upon arrival to the scene, they formally assume command from the first responder.

This course provides the tools a person needs to assume control of an emergency response to a hazardous materials incident. It focuses on legal and practical requirements to manage a hazardous materials incident safely and competently. Instructional methods include class activities, case studies, and tabletop exercises, with an emphasis on hands- on decision-making.

Prerequisites: Hazardous Materials First Responder Operational; Haz Mat Decon - Recommended
