

Special Event Permit Application

You must have an approved Special Event permit from the San Luis Obispo County Planning Department prior to applying with the Fire Department.

The operational permit issued by County Fire is to ensure all life safety measures are being met and it is not approval for the event.

An invoice will be generated upon submission of this application. All application fees must be paid prior to permit issuance.

Applications shall be submitted not less than 30 days prior to the event.

Outdoor assembly events are regulated by Section 3106 of the California Fire Code. San Luis Obispo County Fire requires applicants to obtain an operational permit prior to the event. The applicant is responsible for submitting plans which include:

- 1. Access for emergency equipment
- 2. Fire service features (water supply/hydrant locations)
- 3. Occupancy load and means of egress.
- 4. Public Safety plan (CFC403.12.2)
- 5. Vegetation management plan
- 6. Cooking appliance use and protection
- 7. Liquified petroleum gas use and locations
- 8. Electrical equipment and wiring
- 9. Generator locations
