



ROPE RESCUE AWARENESS OPERATIONS

This course prepares emergency responders to safely perform operations-level tower rescue in accordance with AHJ policies and procedures. Participants will learn rope rescue fundamentals, fall protection, anchor systems, lowering and mechanical advantage systems, ladder rescue techniques, and low- and high-angle rescue operations.

Training incorporates NFPA 1006 (2021) Awareness and Operations-level competencies.

This class is designed for firefighters with at least three years of full-time or six years of part-time/volunteer experience, as well as emergency personnel who perform rope rescue operations.

Priority for CAL FIRE SLU JAC students and employees.
