



FIRE APPARATUS DRIVER/OPERATOR 1A

This course is designed for fire service personnel who plan to drive and operate fire apparatus. Instruction includes preventive maintenance, routine inspections, testing and servicing functions, apparatus operation in various conditions, backing, maneuvering, turning techniques, and the operation of fixed systems and equipment.

Priority for CAL FIRE / SLC Fire personnel. All other will be admitted pending available seats.



PREREQUISITES

- Must be a FFI with CAL FIRE/SLC
- Possess a valid, current Class C driver's license or higher
- Have a current DGS Defensive Driver Training certificate

- Equipment: Structure PPE or long sleeve Nomex/jacket, helmet, gloves, hearing & eye protection, and a dust mask
