



ROPE RESCUE AWARENESS OPERATIONS

This course prepares emergency responders to safely perform operations-level tower rescue in accordance with AHJ policies and procedures. Training covers rope rescue fundamentals, fall protection, anchor and mechanical advantage systems, lowering operations, ladder rescue techniques, and low- and high-angle rescues.

Training incorporates NFPA 1006 (2021) Awareness- and Operations-level competencies.

Priority for CAL FIRE / SLC Fire personnel. All other will be admitted pending available seats.

- Must be a FFI with CAL FIRE/SLC
- IS-100: Intro to the ICS
- IS-200: ICS for Single Resource & IA
- IS-700: Intro to NIMS
- IS-800: National Response Framework

- Equipment: Structure PPE or long sleeve Nomex/BDU shirt or jacket, helmet, gloves, hearing & eye protection, and a dust mask
